With its traditional Bavarian food, live music, and Schuhplattler dancers, the Gasthof Fraundorfer has been a landmark on this street for almost 100 years. Josef Fraundorfer bought and renovated the building into this restaurant and hotel in 1929. Its front facade with its epic Lüftmalerei depicts a Bavarian wedding, including the toasting bride and groom, guests, and the traditional master of ceremonies, the “Hochzeitslader” – literally, the “Wedding Inviter.”
